If you see a crime in progress phone 9-1-1. The Oceanside RCMP non-emergency number is 250-248-6111. Oceanside RCMP is located at **421 Pym Street North, Parksville**, with public business hours of 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM, Monday to Friday, except holidays.

During this period the Oceanside RCMP received 223 complaints.

File 2026-1741: A business reported being defrauded of \$400,000 responding to an email requesting banking information be updated for a vendor on February 24. The file is under investigation.
